sand carefully the surfaces eliminating each kind of dust

thinning:

Fondo poliuretano N 133 must be catalysed with Catalizzatore CZ 021 and brought at normal viscosity with Diluente MB

catalization relation:

Fondo poliuretano N 133	100 parts
Catalizzatore CZ 021	50 parts
Diluente MB	10 - 20 parts

pot life: 90 minutes

system: spray gun

coats: max 3

interval between coats: not inferior to 30 minutes and not over 90 minutes

sanding: after 12 hours with thin abrasive paper 300, and then with thin abrasive paper 600

component A (Fondo poliuretano N 133) 1 year

component B (Catalizzatore CZ 021) 6 months in closed cans
